ROBERT Side 1

On Gerald: Wondering if this is true.

INT. CIA STATION / US EMBASSY, BERLIN - MOMENTS LATER

Gerald leaves Frost's office.

INT. FROST'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Frost watches him go, thinking. We see he's unsure himself. He picks up the phone, presses a button.

> FROST (into phone) Got a minute, Val?

START INT. ROBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Hector and Robert are in conference. Hector's nursing a bad hangover.

ROBERT

Find him a boyfriend.

HECTOR

What?

ROBERT

Buy him one. That might get him off your back. (grins) So to speak.

Hector's taking this far more seriously.

HECTOR

He'd see through it.

ROBERT

Does it matter?

HECTOR

It's not about me, it's about him. How much he's worth. (MORE)

HECTOR (CONT'D)

He wants evidence that he's important, and he wants it from me.

ROBERT

He is valuable.

HECTOR

My best source.

They think.

HECTOR (CONT'D)

I'm almost considering it.

ROBERT

Not an option. Forget about protocol. Where does it go afterward?

HECTOR

It only gets worse.

ROBERT

Do we have any other Iranians on the hook?

HECTOR

It took six months to recruit him.

They both think.

HECTOR (CONT'D)

Shit.

END

INT. VALERIE'S OFFICE / US EMBASSY, BERLIN - DAY

Daniel is sitting across from Valerie, who looks irritated.

VALERIE

Childhood in Berlin.

Daniel nods.

VALERIE (CONT'D)

Father in military intelligence.

DANIEL

Yes.

VALERIE

Gives a boy something to live up to, no?

BEAUTIFUL WOMAN
It's the modern dilemma.

Hector really likes this. Turns to face her better as Kashif arrives and kisses the woman on the lips.

KASHIF

You met Gretel.

HECTOR

Indeed I did.

INT. BATHROOM / CIA STATION - US EMBASSY, BERLIN - EVENING

Daniel's in a stall, looking at his phone. He's testing the firmware he loaded onto Gerald's phone, and we see that he has access to a variety of controls over it: he can access the phone's microphone and its camera, read all of his text messages, go through Gerald's call history, track his GPS location and even take control of the phone remotely.

He clicks text messages and scrolls through them. There are messages from his wife, in Hungarian, as well as other messages from names he recognizes. Then, there: a message received today from "UNKNOWN": "MITTERNACHT" (Midnight). Daniel focuses on this, alert.

DANIEL

Unsfeld...

EXT. TRAIL RESTAURANT - EVENING

Hector, halfway to drunk, lights a cigarette and takes out his phone. Finds the messaging app Amir used earlier for the emergency meet, and sends a message back to him: "HALLES TOR 7."

START INT. FROST'S OFFICE - EVENING

Frost is with Robert and Valerie, all ready to go home. Through the window, we see Daniel walking out, pocketing his phone.

VALERTE

We're clear. Other than J.S. Colander there's nothing in the data dump that connects to us.

ROBERT

Hell of a loss, though. Did Jemma make nice?

FROST

Did what she could.

ROBERT

What time is it?

VALERIE

Seven.

END

Robert goes into the station; Valerie follows. Frost watches them go to the TV to watch Angela Merkel's speech.

Frost lifts his office phone, dials. Waits for it to connect.

FROST

Henry. It's Steven. Frost. Yeah, I'm sure I'm not the only one calling.

He listens a moment, his face sympathetic. In the other room, Merkel speaks.

FROST (CONT'D)

Look, we all know it's trumped up. The Austrians are shits.

Again, he listens. Longer this time.

FROST (CONT'D)

No, I understand. Just wanted you to know.

Sandra comes into the office, ready to head out. Frost looks at her fondly.

FROST (CONT'D)

Okay, Henry. Soon, then.

He hangs up.

FROST (CONT'D)

What's she saying out there?

SANDRA

Showing off her hurt feelings.

Frost smiles sadly.

INT. CLUB DADA - NIGHT

Lights, lasers, YOUNG REVELERS.
