[JONATHAN WALSH] In his 40s, smooth, effortlessly commanding and charming, could possibly speak with a transatlantic accent. Jonathan runs *Slant Media*, a high-profile news site. Jonathan possesses the "zen" demeanor of a disruptive media / tech icon, and his eccentric habits keep both his competition and his allies on their toes. Jonathan's ability to talk anyone into anything might just be a function of his charisma. Or it might be a sign of a much more subversive and mysterious agenda...SERIES REGULAR. [BARISTA/DON] A very tall, pale guy with a ponytail, Don works as barista in Starbucks. But he isn't what he seems to be. Don is an incredibly (some might say "otherworldly") open-hearted and empathic positive thinker. While the cruel world often conspires to break Don's big-hearted spirit, it almost always emerges intact. ...SERIES REGULAR

[GINA MORRISON] In her 40s, no-nonsense and seemingly very competent. Gina is the leader of StarStruck, a support group for people who believe they've had alien encounters (otherwise known as "Experiencers"). A failed therapist who now works as a manager at Pottery Barn, Gina is an eager and credible mentor who can sometimes come across as rash and slightly reckless. Like most therapists, Gina carries a decent amount of her own baggage around with her. [CHELSEA HEALEY] In her 30s, her repressed soccer mom exterior covers something much darker and subversive. At first glance Chelsea seems like a model housewife, but it quickly becomes clear that she is

[FATHER DOUG] In his 30s, fresh-faced, sincere, open-minded (to a fault sometimes), Father Doug sees himself as a hip priest who "gets it." He manages the community room rentals at Our Lady of Sorrows, the Catholic church where StarStruck meets. Father Doug is fascinated by the group, and goes to great lengths to rent them a room at a discounted price. [NANCY] In her 50s, experienced, put-together, tough as nails, Nancy is Jonathan Walsh's administrative assistant. She is an exceptional admin, and performs her duties with machine-like precision. [JEFF THE GREY] Pragmatic to the point of ruthless, Jeff sees little point in enslaving the human race when they could just as easily be annihilated.
